IN THE MORNING

When we wake up in the morning, we all wake up thinking about the things we need to accomplish throughout the day, whether it's the papers we have to write, assignments to finish, readings to complete, or the people we need to meet. Before any of these things, however, we must remember that we wake up to face another day of a spiritual battle. The question is, How are we preparing ourselves to face all of these things?

When we think of King David, we mostly think of the great things that God did through his life – defeating Goliath, becoming king of Israel, or

being called a man after God's own heart, to name a few. But he had major struggles in his life too. The reason why David is made known to us as a man who went after God's own heart, though, is because every morning, no matter what life season he was in, David did his best to listen for God's voice.

David writes in Psalm 143:8, "Let me hear of your unfailing love <u>each morning</u>, for I am trusting you."

Like David, we must start each day listening for God's voice through His Word, because what we wake up to is pretty much what starts our day.

Whether it's the voices of our friends, the words that we read on our phone, or our own thoughts, we all have an input to start our day. And this input actually shapes how we output throughout the rest of our day.

When David is crying out, "Show me where to walk," he is saying, "I can't face the day in the right way without You. You know the best way, and I trust You. Show me Your way." We can live each day to fulfill God's purpose for us if we seek His voice at the start of each day. We need to listen for God's voice every morning – not just when life is bad

- so that we can know how to live each day with and for Him.

Pursue God in your daily life. Listen for His voice through His Word. Input God at the start of each day, so that you can output with Christ throughout your day.

What's the big deal about baptism?

Baptism signifies a person's union with Jesus Christ in His death and resurrection, as well as with the rest of the people of God, the church. It is an act of proclamation of faith in Jesus Christ alone for salvation. Although there are different interpretations and approaches in how a baptism is carried out, baptism by immersion symbolizes the washing away of their sin and purification from it, symbolizing the person's repentance of their sins and entering a new life in Jesus Christ.

"Don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life."

WHEN DO YOU FEEL MOST ALIVE FOR GOD?

In the midst of our busy lives, it is so easy to overlook the work that God is doing in and through and around us. For many of us, we treat God as just a part of everything we do. During the Praise and Prayer Night on Friday, April 21st, students were asked to meditate on their personal relationship with God - how they want Him to come alive in their everyday life.

When was the last time when you were really on fire for God?
