Dad, We Need to Talk

Communication is an essential part of our lives. Efficiently or with struggle, we express our heart and mind in various ways. We interact with various people to gain information, wisdom and encouragement. However, do we also do likewise with God? Are we efficient in expressing our heart with God, or do we struggle to even say a word? Do we offer our time and respond to His voice?

As we mature, we learn the importance of listening, perceiving, interpreting as well as demonstrating our understanding of a conversation. However, it is noteworthy to point out that we often overlook the essential components of communication in our interaction with God: talking and listening. How can we talk and listen to God in a way that helps us interact with Him meaningfully?

First, talking to God must be **genuine**. Come **honestly** before Him and pour out your heart. We can cry out, "Abba, Father", or whisper to Him. Don't hide away, but run to Him with confidence, knowing that there is "no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus" (Rom 8:1). And when we don't know what to pray for, there is a helper, the Holy Spirit who "helps us in our weaknesses", "intercedes for us" and "searches our hearts" (Rom 8:26-28). Through the Holy Spirit, God allows us to be truthful and shows us what we truly need.

Second, listening to God requires **discipline**. When God reveals Himself, we want to be ready. In order for us to listen for His calling and understand His wisdom, we must **train** ourselves to continuously run to God and to recognize His voice. The flock recognizes the shepherd's voice because they've heard it repeatedly. Likewise, we pinpoint God's voice when we repeat the process of coming before God, and allowing the Holy Spirit to search our hearts.

God longs to communicate with us. He wants to spend time with us and is ready to respond. As a friend, He listens to everything we bring, comforting and encouraging us. As the perfect Father, He listens to our worries and questions and gives us unflawed wisdom. Finally, being the Sovereign Ruler, He exchanges our struggles for "peace at all times and in every way" (2 Thes 3:16) and "gives strength to the weary" (Isa 40:29). God is fully capable and is completely prepared to handle every conversation. So, if you don't know where to begin, repeat after me: "Dad, we need to talk."
